In recent years, most counselling and therapy approaches have acknowledged the importance of the relationship and have developed and written profusely on this topic. The existential tradition argues that the notion of the relationship and more importantly, the inter-relationship is intrinsic to the way we exist in this world. Philosophers and practitioners such as Heidegger, Buber, Rogers, and Yalom wrote extensively on this topic.

More recently Spinelli, Cooper and van Deurzen have added to these thoughts, helping deepen our practice as counsellors and psychotherapists. This workshop will explore these ideas and participants will gain experience in working within the relationship realms of encounter.
