

## Group Leadership - An Existential Approach - 5 days

After the successful 1 and 2-day workshops, The Centre for Existential Practice is now holding a 5-day program on [Group Leadership](#) that will explore the qualities and attitudes of a group leader.

Leading a group requires not only skills and techniques but also the close monitoring of 'self' in relationship to the individual and to the group as an entity in its own right.

Whether you are a coach, therapist, workplace trainer questions such as to what degree, can you as a leader be free to be yourself, when can you be honest and revealing of your 'self' and how will the membership respond to your expression of freedom are posed for consideration.

Over the 5 days we will pose and explore and consider the priorities, the style, and the role of a group leader. The inter-relational realm of being human will provide the backdrop to exploring the existential themes of working within a group.

This workshop is highly experiential and a great opportunity to learn about the Yalom Interpersonal model of group facilitation with the addition of the existential philosophical perspective.

[Alison Strasser](#) will be the co-facilitator and will bring her experience as a team leader and extensive existential knowledge.
